## Step 1: Choose a Sponsored Family to Raise Funds for:

On our website you will find a list of families who are currently in the process of adoption. All families who go through our sponsorship program are adopting children who are most often overlooked for adopted. These are children with special needs, older children and children in sibling groups. Each family's sponsorship page has a picture of the family as well as a short description of their adoption journey.

#### Step 2 Plan and Collect

The first step to ensure a successful "Garage Sale with a Purpose" event is to make a game plan. You will need to think of:

- Where will you host your garage sale?
- Who do you want to host with?
- Where you will get your items?
- What kind of supplies do I need?
- When do you want to host your sale?
- Where will you promote your sale?

#### Where Will You Host:

At Your Home: One of the quickest and easiest locations to host a "Garage Sale with a Purpose" is your own home.

Church Building: If you are having a large garage sale, ask your church if they have an area that you could use. This way, you will not only have more room to set up and sell, but your church members can also participate in the sale. Together you can make an even greater impact for the family you are raising funds for.

**Activity Center**: Another option is to find a local activity center. Many times you can sign up to use space at an Activity Center for free!

**School**: Hosting a Garage Sale at your child's school is a great way to get kids in your community involved in caring for orphans. Check with your child's principal to see if you can spread the word, and invite other families to participate.



# 2.) With Who:

Having more people involved will not only help you plan, set up and run your garage sale, but it will also improve your chances of making a bigger impact for orphans. Think about who you can get involved.





Your Family: Hosting a "Garage Sale with a Purpose" is a great way for your whole family to work together to make a difference. Get your spouse, your kids, grandparents, aunts and uncles, cousins and more to come together. Make this a family service project where you can fellowship together while caring for orphans at the same time.

Your Church Group: One way your church can live out James 1:27 (to care for orphans in their distress) is to host a "Garage Sale with a Purpose". See if your entire Church wants to join together to collect and sell their unwanted items to live out James 1:27. If not the entire church, then maybe your Sunday School class, life group, youth group or even just a few church members can gather together to share your passion for orphans. See if your Pastor will let you make an announcement to get the word out, and see who is interested in getting involved to make a difference for orphans.

Your Neighbors: See if your neighbors are interested in hosting a neighborhood wide "Garage Sale with a Purpose". Neighborhood wide garage sales are a great way to attract more customers, and gather your neighbors together to make a difference. People love neighborhood garage sales because visitors can shop at several garage without having to drive far. In addition, this is a great way to share your passion for orphan care with your neighbors and the local community in hopes that your passion will spread.



Once you get people involved, make sure each person has a role to play in the process. Whether it is collecting items to sale, marketing the event, or pricing your merchandise, it is important that everyone knows they are making a difference.



#### 3.) Where Will You Get Your Items:

Your personal Items: The first place to start is to find things around your house that you are not using, or do not need anymore. Be sure to check your attic, basement, and any storage units you may have. This is a great way to clean up your home of unwanted clutter while changing the life of an orphan!

**Donated Items:** Spread the word to everyone you know that you are having a garage sale for the purpose of helping an orphan come home to their forever family. Many people might not have enough items on their own to host a garage sale, but they may want to donate their items to you to join in on a great cause. Ask you friends, family members, neighbors, co-workers, church members or anyone else you can think of who might want to help. *Facebook is one of the quickest and easiest ways to do this!* 

Local Businesses: Some local restaurants may be interested in donating baked goods, snacks or other items to help you in your cause. If you are having a large sale at your church or a neighborhood sale that will attract lot of attention other local businesses may donate items could bring in a good profit.

#### 4.) What Kind of Supplies Do I Need:

The following are a few essential items that will help make your garage sale run smoothly:

- Tables to display items on.
- Clothing Displays: Clothesline, clothes racks and coat hangers to hang your clothes on.
- Price stickers to price all of your items.
- Chairs for you and your volunteers.
- Garage Sale signs to direct customers to your "Garage Sale with a Purpose".
- Money to Make Change: It is a good rule of thumb to get at least \$100.00 in change with lots of one dollar bills and quarters.

#### 5.) What Day and Time

Saturdays are usually the best day of the week for garage sales. This is when many people are off work and ready to find a good deal. Also starting early between 7 am to 9am is a great time to catch those early bird garage sale shoppers.

#### 6.) Promoting Your Event:

## Step 3: Donate the Proceeds of Your Garage Sale with a Purpose.
